Giselle "I think I will eat your paw" Wake up Skyler, I want to play!




Giselle's First Visit To Sharkey's... **Giselle** "No I can't go on the floor until I am potty trained and have my 16 week shots... Hold me daddy! "

Bonding Time with Bailer.....




Bonding Time with Skyler....Life is good over here!
