


Puppy Cam


Puppy Pickup Day

of the OC GDA group.




Mom says I have such

that means handsome.



My first car ride. I've since been told that this is the only time, I was able to ride in Mom's lap.




Resting in my new Mom's arms.

get used to my bed.




My first weekend, I spent learning where to "get busy", where to eat, and where to sleep. Also, started to get to know my name and my new family.

Here I am at 9 weeks old.




The 2nd day of work, Bodin came with me. There are two beds, but we liked this ONE (and without the blanket)



loved.






Kari and Stephany with Hurley,




This is Auntie Shana...she said she was in "love"

All the lights and decorations. And then presents...





I fell asleep playing with my new toy.
