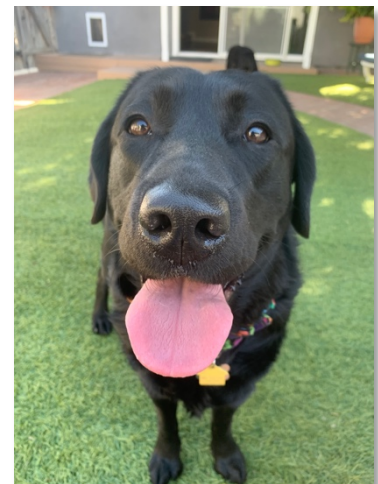


I was pretty tired after all that traveling, so I stopped at Bora Bora on the way home for a little relaxation. I highly recommend it.
